A few items to note as ACT is part of the goals and funding with ACT Prep classes and mini ACT prep-sessions:

 - It was a great year for the Junior's last Spring on the ACT as it is the first time the Jr. Class has beaten the state average in nearly every category!
 - The percentage of Jr's meeting all four benchmarks (23%) was the highest ever, going back to 2015.

As seniors this year, we hope they continue to do well with their Class of 2023 ACT report that comes out next Fall.
