1. **Welcome – SCC Chair, Natalie Dansie**
2. **Review of minutes:** Motioned: Ryan Brimley 2nd: Stephanie Richter. Minutes unanimously approved.
3. **Counseling/Principal Corner Updates (Stacey Murdoch, Quinn Linde, Cheree Larson)**
 - a. **Upcoming 2023-24 Registration Fair / Registration Orientation on Feb. 1 @ 5pm and 6pm**

The registration fair may include a couple of new classes that might be offered next year including an advanced art class incorporating digital graphics. The counselors will also be talking with students about registration during student's English classes and given them the papers for registering. Counselors will return to the English classes approx. 1½ weeks later to pick up the completed registration forms.  - b. **MHS Charities Report for Holiday season –** The SBO's set a high goal of \$25,000 for the 5 for the Fight fundraiser. Although they did not reach the goal, the amount raised of \$16,500 was significantly higher than in previous years. Donations will still be accepted at the MHS Finance office until the check is presented to the Utah Jazz in March.
 - c. **Graduation Requirements – USBE meeting report–** Council member, Cheree Larson, attended a meeting at USBE reassessing the "Utah's Portrait of a Graduate". They looked at models in other states and countries and discussed how to provide more pathways for students including CTE options.
4. **Begin School Land Trust Plan Needs Input 2023-2024 (Quinn Linde) –** Mr. Linde mentioned that 20 of 23 schools in the Salt Lake Valley have been categorized by the state as TSI (Targeted Support Improvement) and Murray High is one of those 20 schools. MHS is placed on TSI for students with disabilities and on warning for the ELL student population. Therefore, those are 2 areas that need to be targeted for improvement as plans are made for the new Land Trust Plan 2023-2024. Mr. Linde will discuss this with his administration team as he prepares a plan to present to the council at the February meeting.
