- 1. Welcome SCC Chair, *Natalie Dansie*

- 3. Council Business: Nofo Teo-Utu has resigned her position on the council. Her seat will remain open until next school year when elections are held.

- 4. Discuss Final Results (Data) from 2021-2022, Principal Linde/Assist. Principle Bird The ELA, Math, Science, and CCR goals for 2021-2022 were reviewed. Overall, there were some areas of growth and other areas of decline.
- 5. Discuss Proposed 2023-2024 Lands Trust Plan (Limited Financial Data at this point.) Principal Linde
 - a. Review Proposed Goals to prepare for March approval This draft document does not show funding amounts as the amounts allotted are not known at this time. The amounts will be included on the draft that is presented for voting in the March SCC meeting. A couple changes of note are that there will be fewer section of before/after school math labs, and more funding for credit recovery.
- 6. Discuss FLEX and APP Mr. Linde presented the planned changes for FLEX class for the 2023-2024 school year. Although the plan is not completely finalized, Mr. Linde hopes the proposed changes will help keep students in school, improve teacher/student relationships, improve student planning and organization skills. This plan will also give students great learning opportunities with the alternate activities planned in the auditorium at "Murray U" during FLEX periods. The opportunity for parents to join the APP to see where their students are going for FLEX is also a great asset.

Mr. Linde also reviewed the plan for a school-wide disclosure replacing the individual teacher disclosure statement (not teacher syllabus). The school-wide disclosure would be on the school website and would eventually replace the M-Book in a much more condensed and concise format.
