- 1. Welcome SCC Chair, Natalie Dansie
- 2. Review of minutes Motion to accept: Stacey Murdoch 2nd: Stephanie Richter Unanimously approved.
- 3. Review Digital Citizenship Plan and Needs: Digital Citizenship Guide The majority of the plan is established by the district I.T. department and is basically the same as last year. The plan includes filtering content on student Chromebooks & sending notice to school administrators of inappropriate searches. The most concerning digital issue is student phone usage, which the district has no control over.

- 4. Data Review and Goals
 - a. October 1 Enrollment MHS enrollment is 1370 which is down from last year and follows the trend we have been seeing in Murray for the past several years.
 - b. Review Flex Data From Sept. 11 thru Oct. 16 (13 flex days) about 6,300 Flex passes have been created by students and teachers. After the end of term 1 (Oct. 26th) a comparison of F grade data with last year at end of term 1 will give some idea of how the flex system is impacting grades. Teachers and administrators will also be discussing ideas and suggestions in Professional Development meetings Oct. 18, 2023.
 - c. Review Attendance Data 88% of MHS students are attending daily. That number is within the state average of 88% 90%
 - d. Review Current F Data This will be done at the end of term 1.

5. Review of 2023-2024 Land Trust / TSSP Plan

a. Review funding changes from Land Trust to TSSA – The projected costs of FTE and ESL/Math aid was not estimated high enough on the Land Trust plan. To accommodate the discrepancy, \$27,000 of the expenditures listed on Land Trust has been shifted to TSSP. Because this change deducts expenditures from Land Trust, rather than adding to them, an amendment is not necessary. This is just informational.

6. Counseling/Principal Corner

a. Halloween Trunk or Treat – This event was very well attended last year and is expected to be at least as well attended this year. It will take place on Oct. 26, 2023 from 4pm to 6pm in the MHS south parking lot.
