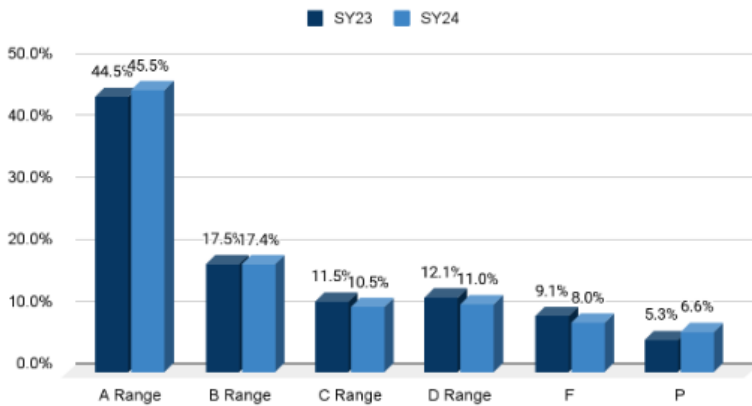

3. **Third Quarter Data** – The chart below shows a comparison of student grades for 3rd quarter between this year and last year. There are more A and B grades this year, with fewer C, D, and F grades.

Principal Linde also mentioned that the recently held Senior Dinner/Dance had approximately 270 students attend. Last school year, Senior Ball had about 325 students, but that included students from other schools, and other grades, whereas those attending this year were all MHS seniors.

The new MHS cell phone policy set to go into effect next school year, was presented to the board of education. Most secondary schools throughout the state are making plans to address cell phone issues in schools. Comparatively, the new MHS plan is less controversial and will hopefully be supported by the community.

4. FLEX changes for 2024-2025 school year - Year FLEX Data/FLEX Updates
Planned change for FLEX next school year is to change the grading a little bit. Grading will continue to be based on attendance, but the criteria will be changed to 0-10 absences for an A grade, 11-15 absences for a P, and 16+ absences is an F grade.
5. Outgoing SCC Members – Natalie Dansie is the only member with a term not ending this year, however she has expressed the desire to leave the council as she will not have a student attending MHS next school year. Council

members are allowed no more than 3 consecutive terms, so, except for Natalie, all council members are eligible to run for re-election for the 2024-2025 school year when elections are held in the fall.
