

Murray High School has a large and diverse student body consisting of students with many differing talents and abilities. The purpose of the Murray Medallion is to encourage and challenge students to be involved in a wide variety of areas while attending Murray High School. The hope is to have students that are well rounded and have participated in many activities. Only 50 points will be accepted within one particular area. The focus is to reward participation and not necessarily achievement. Students can keep track of points throughout high school, and may apply during their senior year. If interested, students can pick up an application for the Murray Medallion from the Counseling Center and return the completed application to their counselor.

A student must earn a minimum of **150 points** to qualify for this award. Points can accumulate from 10<sup>th</sup> through 12<sup>th</sup> grade. The following point values apply to each year of participation at Murray High School. Activities done at other schools will not be accepted. *Signatures verifying participation from administrators, supervisors, teachers, counselors, and/or coaches from the respective area they supervise are required for each activity.
